Call for posters Symposium « Transdisciplinary research for a healthy planet »

of University of Reims Champagne-Ardenne

4th and 5th of December 2025

Article 1 – the Call

The call for posters gives PhD students the opportunity to present their research topic to participants at the “Transdisciplinary research for a healthy planet” symposium.

Two presentation sessions are scheduled: the 4th of December from 1pm to 2:30pm, and the 5th of December from 1pm to 2:30pm. The awards ceremony will take place on the 5th of December at 3.30pm.

Article 2 – Call registration

To participate in the call for posters, applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Speak and write in English,
- Be currently enrolled in a PhD program or have defended their thesis in 2024 or 2025,
- Present a poster in one of the following seven themes:
 1. Green chemistry & biotechnology
 2. Environmental quality
 3. Sustainable crop production
 4. Biobased materials
 5. Society transformation
 6. Health
 7. Renewable energies

The abstract must be submitted via the registration site (<https://symposiumtr4hp3.sciencesconf.org/>)

Article 3 – Technical specifications

- Discussions must take place in English (3 minutes flash presentation and 5 minutes for questions, i.e. 8 minutes of discussion with the jury).
- Attendance at both sessions is mandatory.
- Attendance at the awards ceremony is mandatory.
- The 3 winners of the call for posters will be asked to give a 3 minutes flash presentation with 1 slide as support on their poster after the announcement of the results at the awards ceremony.

Poster printing is the responsibility of the research laboratories.

Article 4 – Evaluation criteria

Jury members will use the following criteria to evaluate candidates:

Poster support: balance/structure of poster, quality of illustrations, visual appeal				
Written expression: spelling, expression, respect of format				
Assimilation of the scientific question				
Ability to listen to questions, take comments into account and provide relevant answers				
Student's ease in front of an audience				
Overall rating (Total score out of 20 points)	/20
